From Monday August 13th the Chemical Pathology laboratory will commence reporting non-HDL Cholesterol on all Lipid Profile requests. As there is no requirement to fast for routine Lipid Profile measurement, you can now order both fasting and non-fasting lipid profiles which will be reported with the appropriate primary prevention target values (see below) and interpretive comments.
