The Chemical Pathology will be changing our Prolactin assay from Beckman to Roche from Monday July 6^{th} onwards.

There will be a change to the Reference Intervals and testing procedure.

The new assay will have an additional test performed if the Total Prolactin result is above the reference interval.

These samples will have a reflex repeat analysis following PEG precipitation to give a Bioactive Prolactin value.

Results will be reported as Total Prolactin and Bioactive Prolactin along with new method specific reference intervals.

Bioactive Prolactin is the biologically active form of Prolactin and should be used, in conjunction with clinical findings, to guide further investigation and/or treatment..
