Dear Colleague

From October 1st 2020 onwards the Chemical Pathology laboratory will be implementing the recommendations of the National Laboratory Handbook-Laboratory Testing for Vitamin D Deficiency. Testing will be reserved for specific patient groups with relevant clinical indications.

All Vitamin D test requests must be accompanied by relevant clinical details.

Samples received with no clinical details will not be analysed.

Request forms will be checked for relevant clinical indications.

Testing will continue to be available for those with metabolic bone disorders and other relevant clinical conditions.

Vitamin D testing is not recommended in asymptomatic healthy individuals.

General screening of patient subgroups (e.g. nursing homes) or for health screening is not recommended.

Routine repeat testing is not required.


