Position Summary:

The Department of Health has agreed a draft policy to develop a framework to create a critical mass of Registered Advanced Nurse Practitioners/Registered Advanced Midwife Practitioners through development pathways for graduate and specialty nurses and midwives. The core objective of this policy is to assist in meeting the challenges currently being experienced in the Irish Health care services through reengineering nursing and midwifery care and services.

Beaumont hospital has been selected to become a demonstrator site in the above area and seek a suitably experienced and interested nurse to become a Candidate Advanced Nurse Practitioner in the above specialty.

Mandatory:

Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

- Are on the active register in the Division of the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland register for which the application is being made or be eligible to register in the Division of Nursing, and Midwifery Board of Ireland register for which the application is being made
- AND**
- Have a minimum five years post registration nursing/midwifery experience including a minimum of three years clinical experience in the specialist area of practice
- AND**
- Hold a minimum of a level 9 National Qualifications Authority of Ireland major academic award or equivalent post registration qualification relevant to the specialist area of practice.

AND

Possess a Masters Degree in Nursing/Midwifery (or higher) (Advanced Practice Pathway). The post graduation programme must be in an area of Nursing or Midwifery or an area highly relevant to the area of specialist practice. Educational preparation must include a substantial clinical modular component pertaining to the relevant area of specialist practice



OR

Be currently undertaking a Masters Degree in Nursing/Midwifery (Advanced Practice Pathway) or be eligible to register to undertake additional level 9 specific modules of a Masters Degree in Nursing/Midwifery (Advanced Practice Pathway) within an agreed timeframe. The post graduation programme must be in an area of Nursing or Midwifery or an area highly relevant to the area of specialist practice. Educational preparation must include a substantial clinical modular component pertaining to the relevant area of specialist practice
