The Chemical Pathology Laboratory is reconfiguring the following test profiles in line with recent recommendations. Please note that from July 24th 2019 onwards the Liver Profile and Bone Profile will include the following tests:

U/E will be replaced by Renal Profile and the tests within this profile will remain as they currently are.

Magnesium (Mg²⁺) can be requested as a separate test when required.

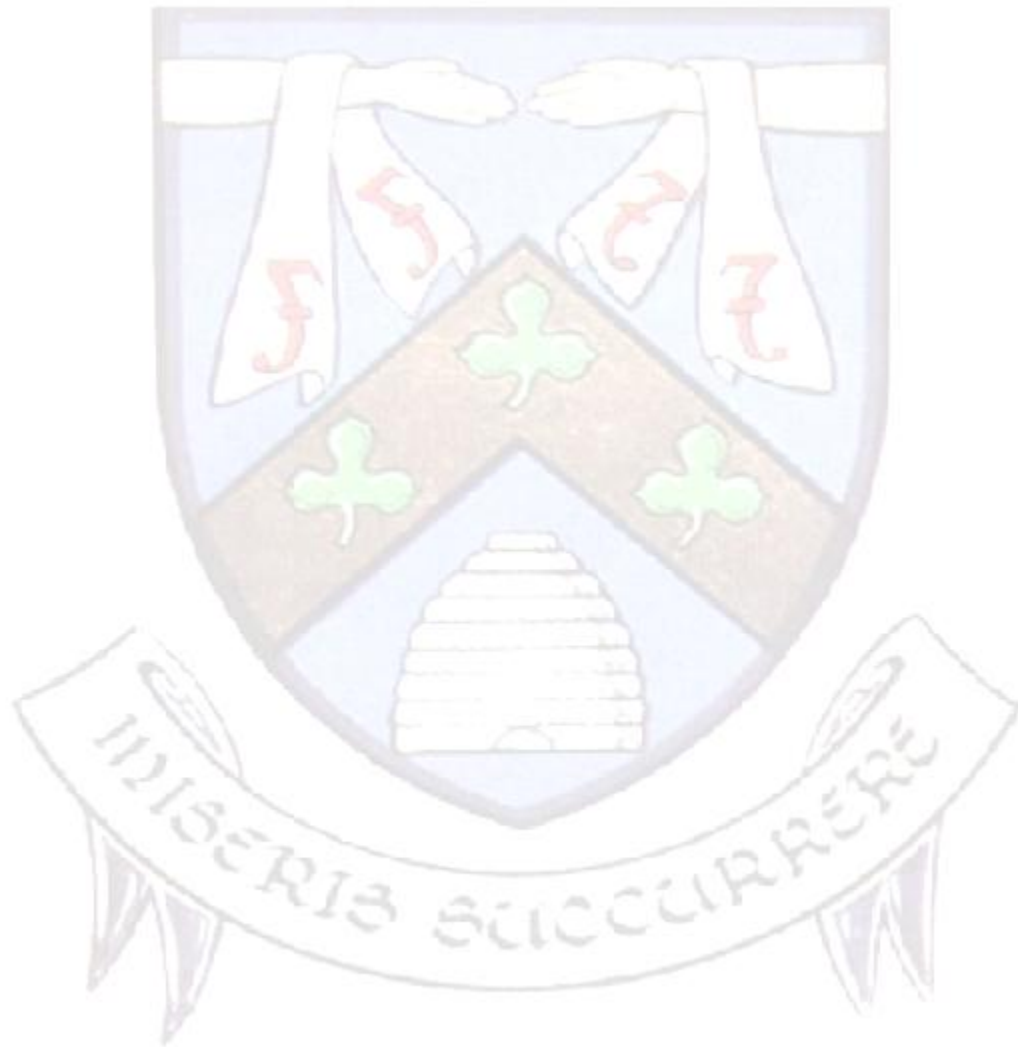
