## Who can volunteer?



Beaumont Hospital welcomes meet and greet volunteers from our Community who;

- are over 18 years of age
- can commit to at least **3 hours per week** on a regular basis
- have good communication skills
- are fluent in English

## What is the role of volunteer?

- Meet and greet volunteers provide a friendly welcome to our patients and visitors who enter the main reception area of the hospital.
- They assist with accompanying patients to various departments or giving directions within the hospital.
- Volunteers observe for individuals who look lost or unsure of where they are going and offer to assist them.
- Assist with telephoning for relatives and/or taxis.
- Have a professional and approachable manner to patients, visitors and staff.

## What else do I need to consider?

Our meet and greet volunteers meet a variety of people on a daily basis, some may speak other languages or others may be experiencing difficult situations.

This requires our volunteers to be sensitive, have empathy, show kindness whilst maintaining patient confidentiality at all times.

**Monday to Friday; 9am to 12pm & 1pm to 4pm**

## Recruitment Process

All of our volunteers must provide two independent references and will be provided with induction training.

You will also be requested to complete Garda Vetting.
